- (1) Cumulative 2.75 GPA or higher
- (2) Successful completion of PRAXIS Core Exams
- (3) Satisfactory rating on three student disposition forms (one must be from EDUC1010 or ECED1310)
- (4) Completion of 30 documented field experience hours
