

M.O.S.T. Fall 2018 Scholarship Criteria

Scholarships are available to individuals accepted in the M.O.S.T. program. Scholarship is renewable provided criteria are maintained and will be prioritized based upon financial need.

- 1. Returning adults or incoming freshmen may apply.
- 2. Due to limited funds, students are **only** eligible for **three (3) PREVIOUS awards**.
- 3. Must be accepted, and currently active in the M.O.S.T. program
- 4. Must be **currently enrolled** in and actively participating in classes **only** at Southwest.
- 5. Applicant must agree to work with an **Advisor** and a **Counselor** throughout their academic career. Failure to do so will make the applicant ineligible for future funding.
- 6. Applicant must agree to serve a <u>minimum of 16 hours</u> each semester of community service outlined by the program staff. Community service must be documented on the form provided and **signed** by the person/program providing oversight.
- 7. Applicant must maintain a **minimum of 90% attendance rate in classes**, maintain good academic standing, attend the summer I.C.E. (Introduction to College Excellence) activities, join a student organization, and attend workshops and other M.OS.T. sponsored activities.
- 8. Full or part-time students are eligible to apply for an award.
- 9. After the initial award, awards may be renewed **if recommended by the Counselor AND** if recipient **maintains a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA** along with satisfactory participation (i.e., must attend and participate in M.O.S.T. activities).
- 10. May pursue any certificate or degree program.
- 11. Must demonstrate a strong desire to succeed and strictly adhere to the program's **Code of Ethics**.
- 12. Must submit a completed 3-paragraph essay explaining why they should receive the scholarship
- 13. All applicants must have completed the financial literacy workshop outlined by program staff.
- 14. All scholarships and amounts are contingent upon availability of funds.
